

Notification of the Ministry of Commerce
Re: The use of non-automatic weighing instrument
with digital indicator system for gold retailing

In light of the fact that the use of weighing instruments for gold retailing requires standardized practices to ensure fairness for both buying and selling parties;

By virtue of Section 5 and Section 25 (paragraph two) of the Weights and Measures Act B.E. 2542 (1999), which contains certain provisions in relation to the restriction of the rights and liberty of a person whereby in respect to Section 29 in conjunction with Section 31, Section 35, Section 48 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permitted by virtue of the law, therefore, the Minister of Commerce hereby issues the Notification as follows.

Clause 1 This Notification shall come into force after three hundred sixty-five days following the published date in the Government Gazette.

Clause 2 The user of a non-automatic weighing instrument with a digital indicator system for gold retailing shall observe the following steps:

- (1) using the instrument calibrated by the Secondary Standard of the (e) certified gold standard of not over 0.1 gram, and with the (d) certified gold standard of not over 0.01 gram;
- (2) positioning the instrument to enhance clear visibility of the weighing by all parties concerned or else one additional digital weighing screen shall be provided to facilitate required visibility at the same moment for all observers.
