

## NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE

RE: NEW INSPECTION IN THE CASE OF MOVING A WEIGHTS AND MEASURES INSTRUMENT  
ATTACHED AND IMMOVABLE AND HAS ALREADY BEEN INSPECTED B.E. 2559 (2016)

As the Ministry of Commerce has issued the Notification of the Ministry of Commerce on the prescription of type of a weights and measures instrument attached and immovable which has already been inspected and once being moved to install at a new place, it shall be inspected for accuracy B.E. 2552 dated the 8<sup>th</sup> of September B.E. 2552 to ensure that sale or exchange of goods and calculation of remuneration is accurate and fair:

It is expedient to amend such Notification of the Ministry of Commerce to be in accordance with section 27 of the Weight and Measures Act B.E. 2542 as amended by the Weight and Measures Act (No. 3) B.E. 2557 which prescribes that an attached and immovable weights and measures instrument which has already been inspected and has been moved must be newly inspected. By virtue of section 5 and section 27 of the Weight and Measures Act B.E. 2542 as amended by the Weight and Measures Act (No. 3) B.E. 2557, the Minister of Commerce hereby issues the Notification as follows:

**Clause 1.** This Notification shall come into force as from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

**Clause 2.** An attached and immovable weighing machine or a length measurer which has already been inspected, upon moving, a possessor of such attached and immovable weighing machine or a length measurer which shall notify, in writing, the Central Bureau or subsidiary office within fifteen days as from the date of completion of installation for a competent official to conduct new inspection.

**Clause 3.** Weighing machines or length measurers which must be inspected under clause 2 are as follows:

- (1) non-automatic weighing machine with the capacity of 20 metric tones and beyond;
- (2) fuel meter in service station;
- (3) fuel meter in service station with combined equipment and complement equipment as credit card;
- (4) liquefied petroleum gas meter in service station;
- (5) direct mass measurement gauge for measuring natural gas in service station
