**Warning** (1) The applicant for transporting the onion as imported from foreign countries has a duty to give the white original letter of permission and documents under paragraph four of Article 7, as the case may be, to the Provincial Commercial Office of the area or the Department of Internal Trade within 48 hours as from the time of the transport arriving at the destination, or to deliver such documents by the registered and replied mail, whereby the date when there is a daily seal affixed at the post office shall be deemed as the date of delivery. (2) If the applicant fails to do so or the specified period of time is over, he/she shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years or for a fine not exceeding 100,000 Baht, or both.
